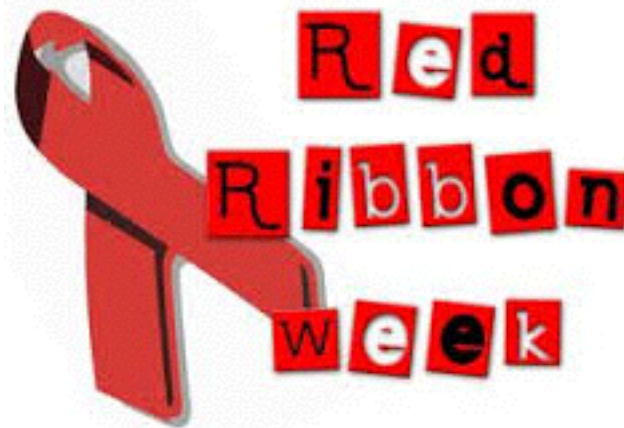

- Phonics: Long A Blends

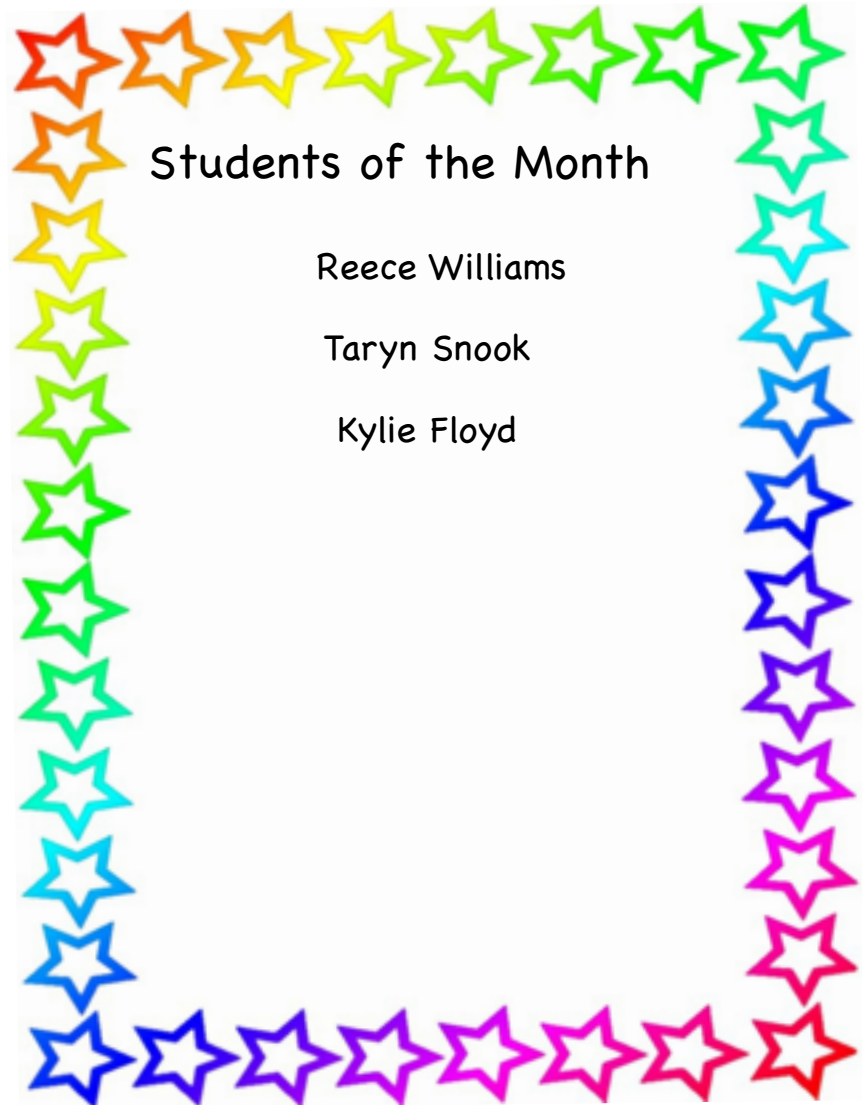
